Conceptually

- Purpose – The RCE model is designed to:
 - Provide cohesive, focused systemic support, and investment
 - Maximize resources, build capacity, and promote sustainability
 - Increase educational equity, excellence, and efficacy for all students*
- A National Best Practice

“Regional” or “region” refers to a service area encompassing Maricopa County. An RCE is a grouping or collection of program offerings wherever located within the District (administered by one or more college) serving the entire region without regard to the geographic home of the student or user of the services.

Centers of Excellence in Strategic Areas

- Redefining excellence and learning communities.
- Organized to pool expertise and resources:
 - **Philosophy** – Stewardship and the leveraging of district resources to offer competitive and superior program offerings throughout the region
 - Emphasizes *intentional differentiation* among the colleges and a *sharing of resources* throughout the district
 - Decision-making methodology balances stewardship objectives with questions of access, program viability/sustainability, and community engagement

Present Model

- Colleges determine offerings based on geographic service-area needs.
- Leads to:
 - Meeting local needs of narrow geographic area, non systemic
 - Scattering of signature programs and unheralded pockets of excellence
 - Missed opportunities to optimize resources, redundancies
 - Internal rather than external competition
 - Technology outpaces resources

New Model

- Looking beyond geographic lines to construct and align programs to best meet the needs of the region and the community at-large.
- Leads to:
 - Maximizing limited resources for the common good
 - Increased peer mentoring and development opportunities
 - Foundational to student success (career pathways, course sequencing, advising, etc...)
 - Pooling resources to create rich, robust offerings and depth of expertise
 - Systemic, strategic and data-driven program investment decisions
 - Alignment with regional economic development needs leading to increased public-private partnerships
 - Shining a light on and validating excellence



Note: Careers appearing as bullets are exemplars and not a complete list. They represent in-demand careers and are current instructional offerings for illustration purposes.

RCE Decision-Making Protocol and Criteria

- Driven by the ONE Maricopa Vision
- Collective-Decisive model, Chancellor is the decisive
- Proposed RCE Council recommends framework and model that fulfills stated RCE purpose
- Honors established curriculum governance
- Critical success factors:
 - Transparency of and dedication to process
 - Stakeholder engagement and 2-way communication
 - Application of objective criteria (draft survey shared for feedback)
 - Commitment to common good
 - Evidence-based and data-driven decision-making
 - New policy creation and accountability in execution
